

# Collaborating on major infrastructure projects for economic and community growth.

Calgary's infrastructure focuses on building a vibrant and resilient city for both current and future generations. Collaborating on and supporting major infrastructure projects helps the city invest in creating inclusive, accessible, connected and resilient communities.





#### CAPITAL COST:

Estimated \$160 million

#### **PROJECT BENEFITS:**

#### **Usage:**

 Estimated 3,500 passengers per weekday

#### **Reduced Emissions:**

 Saves up to 1,500 tonnes of greenhouse gas emissions a year

#### **Job Creation:**

Estimated 771 regional jobs during construction

#### **Improved Mobility:**

- Estimated 11,000 Calgarians living within 800m of the station in 2048
- Estimated 1,200 jobs within 800m of the station in 2028

#### **Service Enhancements:**

- Serves new and developing communities and provides the transfer station between the Blue Line and Airport Transit Connector
- Improves travel time and reliability converting from bus to LRT

#### PROJECT FEATURES:

- 1 km extension from Saddletowne Station
- 1 new station
- Future connection to Calgary International Airport via the Airport Transit Connection
- Small 'Park and Ride' and a bus loop
- Community Activity Centre with planning and development underway for Transit Oriented Development
