Notice of application to be filed for approval with the Alberta Utilities Commission for a new electricity franchise agreement between The City of Calgary and ENMAX Power Corporation

Application summary:

ENMAX Power Corporation will file an application for a new franchise agreement with The City of Calgary, following the submission deadline indicated below.

The franchise agreement will, subject to approval, continue to allow ENMAX Power Corporation the exclusive right to deliver electricity to the residents of The City of Calgary for approximately 20 years from the effective date of the franchise agreement.

The franchise fee rate rider percentage will change from 11.11 per cent of Distribution Tariff charges and 11.11 per cent of the monthly RRO Energy charge to approximately 19.2 per cent of Distribution Tariff charges (or \$0.015507 per kilowatt-hour consumed) effective January 1, 2025. The average monthly franchise fee for an average residential customer is forecast to decrease to \$7.91 a month in 2025, down 30 per cent from an estimated \$11.24 a month in 2024. An average residential customer uses about 6,119 kilowatt-hours per year.
