5G Discovery Zone

The 5G Discovery Zone is a downtown 5G testbed for exploring how 5G technology can help cities address complex challenges. A collaboration between The City of Calgary, Rogers, Platform Calgary, and Calgary Economic Development, the Zone provides a space to develop, test, and scale technologies that can make cities smarter, safer, and more sustainable. This initiative aims to address specific urban challenges in areas like **Transportation & Mobility, Public Safety, and Climate & Environment.**

Connected Calgary

Introducing **Connected Calgary**, a new cohort program designed to accelerate solution development and align startup innovation with civic and industry challenges. This initiative will explore how 5G can be leveraged to accelerate innovation and solve complex challenges. Connected Calgary will focus on an overarching challenge statement, and applicants can respond to the statement under one or more of the three key focus areas: **Transportation & Mobility, Public Safety, and Climate & Environment.**

Note: Solutions must be at a **Technology Readiness Level (TRL) of 6 or higher**. This means validated solutions ready for demonstration in a relevant environment are eligible. Early-stage concepts, untested prototypes, or ideation-stage projects will not be accepted.

Challenge Statement:

"How might we leverage 5G connectivity and data to make cities safer, more sustainable, or more responsive"

Examples:

The following are examples to help inspire ideas. Applicants are welcome to use these examples, adapt them, or propose entirely new solutions within the three focus areas:

Focus Area: Public Safety

Use AI and sensor data to improve safety at high-risk intersections or public areas.

Focus Area: Climate & Environment

Leverage flood and air quality data to support faster, more informed decision-making.

Focus Area: Transportation & Mobility

Optimize transit systems and reduce congestion by harnessing 5G connectivity from infrastructure and vehicles.
