- In December 2011, Calgary's 12-month-moving-average inflation rate increased to 2.2 per cent from 2 per cent in November 2011 and 0.8 per cent in December 2010. Nationally, the inflation rate remained unchanged at 2.9 per cent in December 2011 from last month, but increasd from 1.8 per cent in December 2010.
- The unemployment rate in the Calgary Economic Region (CER) was 4.9 per cent in December 2011, down from 5.9 per cent in the same time of previous year. Nationally, the unemployment rate was 6.9 per cent, down from 7.1 per cent in December 2010.
- Total employment in the CER was 794,300 in December 2011, an increase of 37,300 from 757,000 in December 2010.
- In December 2011, the average hourly wage in Calgary was \$27.37, an increase of 4.3 per cent compared to a year ago. In Alberta, the average hourly wage was \$26.03, an increase of 2.6 per cent compared to December 2010.
- Between November 2010 and November 2011, the number of Calgarians receiving regular employment insurance fell by 41.7 per cent to 6,930. In Alberta, the number fell by 38.7 per cent to 28,750.
- In December 2011, the average price of crude oil (WTI) was US\$98.58/ bbl, up 1.5 per cent from November 2011. The average price of natural gas (AECO) was \$2.81/GJ, down 9.1 per cent from the previous month.
- The Canadian prime business loan rate remained unchanged at 3 per cent in December 2011.

- The Index of Consumer Confidence dropped 6.5 points in December 2011 from the previous month to 69.9 (2002 = 100). The index is down 11.1 points from where it was at the end of 2010.
- In November 2011, Alberta retail sales were estimated at \$5.6 billion (seasonally adjusted), a 1 per cent increase over the previous month and a 8.2 per cent increase year-over-year.
- Alberta wholesale merchants' sales were estimated at \$6.4 billion (seasonally adjusted) in November 2011, down 0.7 per cent from the previous month but up 15 per cent from November 2010.
- Alberta manufacturing sales were estimated at \$6.4 billion (seasonally adjusted) in November 2011, up 5.9 per cent from the previous month and 23 per cent from November 2010.
- In December 2011, total housing starts in Calgary (CMA) reached 970 units, down from 1,106 units in November but up from 486 units a year ago.
- Calgary housing sales in December 2011 was 1,255 units, down 24.3 per cent from 1,658 units in November but up 0.4 per cent from 1,250 units a year
- December's MLS average sale price for Calgary was \$407,637, down 0.5 per cent from last month's average of \$409,729, but up 4.5 per cent from \$390,124 a year ago.

Note: In January 2011, Statistics Canada applied a standard revision to its Labour Force Survey estimates following the release of final population estimates from Census 2006. As a result, the data that are related to employment have been revised accordingly.
