







# **2017**Residential Property Taxes and Utility Charges Survey



#### Introduction

This year's survey of participating Canadian municipalities contains information on the 2017 taxation year. Participating Canadian municipalities responded to the survey via e-mail. This publication includes all survey responses.

Some participating municipalities chose not to answer some questions, and in some instances, we have had to supplement information from public sources like the Alberta 2017 Education Property Tax Requisitions. As such, there may be different numbers of participants for each table and graph contained in this report.

#### **Methodology**

A preliminary survey was sent out in the spring. Responses came in over the subsequent months, and we have made efforts to confirm numbers with survey participants. Audited financial statements, annual budgets and property tax bylaws provided missing information in some cases. This year most municipalities answered the electricity question, and we did not have to obtain rate information from electric utilities serving Canadian municipalities.

Utility numbers were collected or calculated under these assumptions:

- per a "typical" month consisting of 30.4 days:
  - 600 kW/h usage of electricity,
  - 19 cubic meters of water usage, and
  - 17.5 cubic meters of wastewater disposal.

- Other charges on a per-residential-dwelling basis:
  - recycling fees,
  - garbage disposal, and
  - other

The definition of a "representative bungalow" used in this survey is:

- twenty-five to thirty-years-old,
- single detached,
- three-bedroom bungalow with a main floor area of 1,200 square feet,
- a double car garage,
- a finished full basement,
- on a 6,000 square-foot lot located in an average neighbourhood of the city.

The definition of a "representative two-storey" used in this survey is:

- A 2-storey,
- 3-bedroom,
- 2-bathroom,
- single-family house with double attached garage or car port,
- with an average 1,500 square feet of above grade living space (including only those houses with 1,100 to 1,900 square feet into the calculations),
- located in an average neighbourhood.

The practice in Vancouver is to have a semifinished crawl space instead of a basement, so there are no "representative single-family houses" in Vancouver. In keeping with their prior participation in this survey, Vancouver provided average taxation information across all singlefamily homes instead.

#### **Executive Summary**

Calgary's municipal property tax is below the average for large Canadian cities that responded to the survey. In 2017, Calgary ranked #1 and #5 for a representative Two-Storey and Bungalow home respectively.

When we add the average annual residential utility and other charges to the municipal property taxes, Calgary ranked #3 and #4 for a representative Two-Storey and Bungalow home respectively.














#### **B.** Net Property Tax (Total Property Tax less Grants to Homeowners)









## C. Total Property Tax (Average and Median)













## G. Average Monthly Utility Charges





## H. Combined Municipal Property Tax and Utility Charges











## I. Combined Net Property Tax and Utility Charges











## J. Combined Total Property Tax and Utility Charges (Average)




