Did you know most vehicle break-ins are crimes of opportunity? Thieves look for these chances—they can happen anywhere and they can happen quickly. By taking a few simple steps, you can protect your vehicle from a break-in.

How to protect your vehicle and belongings:

1. Lock all doors and close all windows.
2. In the summer, ensure your sunroof is closed or your convertible top is up.
3. Do not leave a spare key hidden inside the vehicle.
4. Do not leave your vehicle running while unattended.
5. Park in well-lit, designated parking areas, and avoid unlit areas at night.
6. Never leave valuables or money in your vehicle.
7. Know what your key fob can do, and what its limits are. Can someone start your car if the fob is close by?

Common items stolen from vehicles:

- Personal computers or tablets
- Cell phones
- Wallets, purses, handbags and backpacks
- Jewelry
- Money
- Cameras
- Clothing
- Shopping packages
- Tools
- Personal documents
- Garage door openers
