Executive Summary

The Calgary Police Service has been tracking the impact of the Covid-19 state of public health emergency on crime, disorder, and collision patterns in the city. Since the state of emergency was declared on March 15th, 2020, general call and crime volumes have shown noteworthy reductions. Restrictions on gatherings, closures of public spaces and the large portion of the population being home-bound have increased guardianship in residential areas and reduced the opportunity for certain crimes, such as robberies, break and enters and thefts of and from vehicles. As restrictions have been lifted violent crime has shown an increasing trajectory. Overall calls for service continue to track below expected levels; and, although throughout much of the pandemic there was an increase in citizen's reports of disorderly behaviours and non-criminal domestic conflict, these both returned to average levels in the 2nd Quarter (Q2) of 2021.

- Homicides are down: There were three homicides in Q2 2021, a 60% decrease from the average for this period. One of the six homicides for this year was domestic-motivated.
- Overall violence is up: violent crime has been trending above average levels since March of 2021. June saw the largest single-month increase over the average for the month which is associated to the easing of restrictions and seasonality.
- The pandemic has impacted the types of crimes committed: Criminal harassment, harassing communications and uttering threats have increased notably under the influence of the pandemic.
- Robberies are on the rise: A spike in pharmacy robberies contributed to the overall rise in commercial robberies. Not surprisingly, person robberies are increasing as more people are out and about creating opportunities for offenders to rob people of their cell phones and other items.
- Domestic Violence Victimization decreased in Q2: this reduction was driven largely by fewer reported 'Level 1' (common) assaults. There was, however, a 28% increase in the numbers of victims reporting more serious assaults.
- Property crime activity still tracking lower than average (18% lower): property crimes have been most affected by the societal movement pattern changes and restrictions from mid-March 2020 forward. Deep reductions in break and enters, shoplifting, general thefts and vehicle-related thefts have had the greatest impact on crime volume reductions when comparisons are made to pre-pandemic numbers.
- Total Break and enters (BEs) are down 37% below average: Q2 2021 dwelling and commercial BEs decreased 44% and 40% respectively compared to the five-year average. Vehicle thefts remain nearly one-quarter below the five-year average.
- Calls from the Public increased in Q2: from April to June police attended ~1030/calls a day. Q2 saw more citizens using Coplogic to report crimes - ~50 reports/day.
- As Covid restrictions eased, traffic collisions increased – in 2021 seven people have died on Calgary's roads compared to eleven the previous year. Q2 saw an increase in injury collisions, where 5 people everyday suffered an injury resulting from a collision.

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REPORT NOTES

Most of the statistical data in this report is derived from the Calgary Police Service records management system (SENTRY) and compiled by the Resource and Project Team/Bureau of Service & Community Support. Disorder data is derived from the Computer aided Dispatch (CAD) system.

Reporting is based on the most serious offence in the incident. Please note that offences are assigned to the month in which the offence was reported, which is not necessarily the month the offence occurred. The reported date is the first point in time at which the police were notified of the offence and reporting lag may vary due to circumstances (these are typically property crimes where the victim did not report the offence until a later date, or was unaware of the loss until a later date, or late-reported sexual assaults). Also note that “attempted” offences are included in these totals. Violent crime, excluding robbery, is counted by the number of victims, using the most serious offence against the victim. Robbery, and all other crime, is counted by incident using the most serious offence in the incident. Of note, cases are often cleared months and sometimes years later. Consequently, clearance rates for previous years may appear to be much higher than those of the present year. Cases “cleared by charge” and those “cleared otherwise” are included in these clearance rate totals.

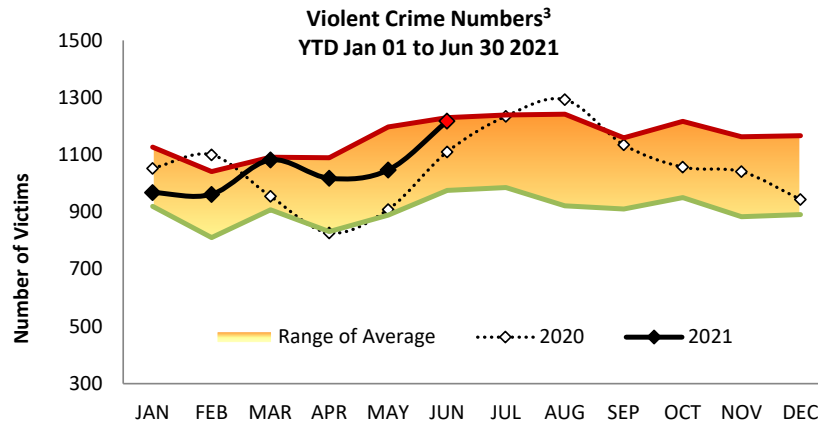

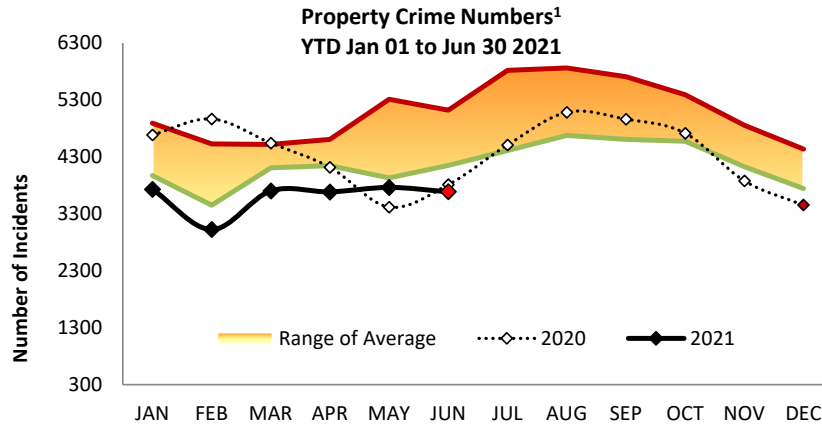

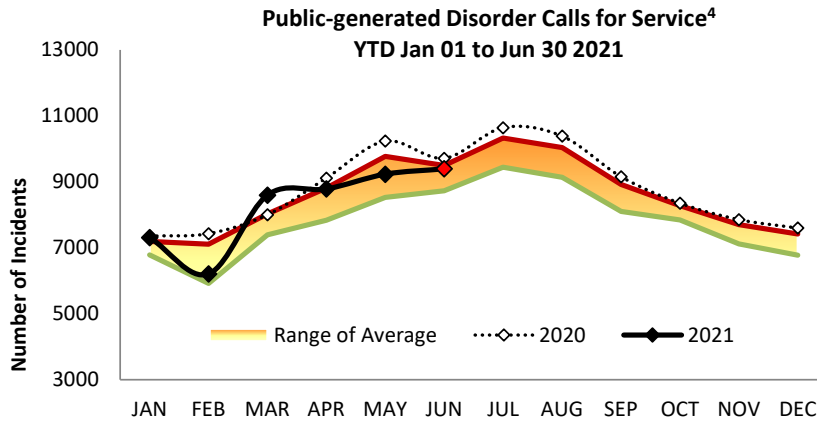

The implementation of the new provincial legislation (*Provincial Administrative Penalties Act*) has resulted in a significant reduction in impaired offences under the *Criminal Code* as most first time impaired drivers will be subject to only an IRS:FAIL (the specific administrative penalty under the Traffic Safety Act for criminal level impaired driving offences), unless the incident results in death or serious bodily harm or other significant aggravating factors in which case criminal charges should also be pursued.
