Executive Summary

- There were seven homicides during the 1st Quarter of 2022, a 75% increase from the five-year average; this represented four additional homicides over the 1st Quarter of 2021. One of the seven homicides was domestic-motivated.
- Reported sexual offences dropped from the 1st Quarter of 2021, returning to average levels. However, there was a noteworthy increase in sexual assaults involving a weapon or causing bodily harm.
- Assaults increased to pre-pandemic levels, with common assaults and assaults with a weapon driving the increase. Assaults with a weapon or causing bodily harm, as well as assaults against peace officers were at six-year highs for the Quarter.
- The presence of weapons in violent crime continues to remain higher than expected. There was a 36% increase in firearms, as well as substantial increase in the presence of edged weapons, clubs, blunt objects, and other weapons.
- Non-physical violent crime such as extortion, criminal harassment, harassing communications, and uttering threats had increased notably under the influence of the pandemic but dropped slightly from levels reached in the 1st Quarter of 2021.
- Commercial robberies reached a six-year high; pharmacy, cannabis and cell phone stores remain thematic targets.
- The number of victims of domestic violence dropped slightly from the previous year, remaining well below the 5-year average baseline. However, higher severity assaults remain higher than average, continuing the trend seen in 2021. Reports of domestic conflict also increased 14%.
- For the first time since the start of the pandemic, property crime volumes started to increase towards the end of the 1st Quarter. Commercial break and enters, and vehicle crimes increased notably in March.
- Overall, break and enters were slightly higher than average in the 1st Quarter, with commercial B&Es reflecting the largest numerical increase. Thefts of and from vehicles started to return to pre-pandemic levels.
- The number of young offenders identified in the 1st Quarter dropped 37%, with the reduction in property crime involvement driving the overall decrease.
- The total number of police service requests was 9% lower than the five-year average. Citizen use of the online reporting system grew by 91%. In the 1st Quarter police attended an average of 950 calls a day. Online citizen reports averaged 56 per day.
- Calls about disorderly behaviours rose by nearly 7%. Calls about mental health concerns, unwanted guests, threats, and disturbances increased most notably. Disorder calls accounted for an average of 231 calls a day from the public.

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REPORT NOTES

Most of the statistical data in this report is derived from the Calgary Police Service records management system (SENTRY). Disorder data is derived from the Computer aided Dispatch (CAD) system. Data is compiled by the Corporate Data and Analytics Team of the Bureau of Service & Community Support.

Reporting is based on the most serious offence in the incident. Please note that offences are assigned to the month in which the offence was *reported*, which is not necessarily the month the offence occurred. The reported date is the first point in time at which the police were notified of the offence and reporting lag may vary due to circumstances (these are typically property crimes where the victim did not report the offence until a later date, or was unaware of the loss until a later date, or late-reported sexual assaults). Also note that “attempted” offences are included in these totals. Violent crime, excluding robbery, is counted by the number of victims, using the most serious offence against the victim. Robbery, and all other crime, is counted by incident using the most serious offence in the incident. Of note, cases are often cleared months and sometimes years later. Consequently, clearance rates for previous years may appear to be much higher than those of the present year. Cases “cleared by charge” and those “cleared otherwise” are included in these clearance rate totals.

The implementation of the new provincial legislation (Provincial Administrative Penalties Act) has resulted in a significant reduction in impaired offences under the Criminal Code as most first time impaired drivers will be subject to only an IRS:FAIL (the specific administrative penalty under the Traffic Safety Act for criminal level impaired driving offences), unless the incident results in death or serious bodily harm or other significant aggravating factors in which case criminal charges should also be pursued.
