Executive Summary

- There were eight homicides during the 2nd Quarter of 2022, a 14% increase from the five-year average. By the end of the 2nd Quarter the number of homicide victims for 2022 rose to 15, up 36% over average; this represents eight additional homicides over the first half of 2021. Three of the fifteen homicides were domestic-motivated.
- Reported sexual offences dropped from the 2nd Quarter of 2021 but were 8% above average as a result of an increase in both assaults with a weapon or causing bodily harm and Level 1 (common) sexual assaults.
- Assaults were at average levels, although assaults with a weapon or causing bodily harm, assaults against peace officers and discharge of a firearm with intent registered increases during the Quarter.
- The presence of weapons in violent crime continues to remain higher than expected. The presence of firearms registered an increase of 54%. The presence of edged weapon remained in line with average and substantially lower than last year during the same period.
- Non-physical violent crime such as extortion, criminal harassment, harassing communications, and uttering threats increased notably under the influence of the pandemic. During the 2nd Quarter of 2022, criminal harassment and uttering threats registered notable reductions from 1st Quarter 2021.
- Commercial robberies were 58% higher than average; pharmacy, cannabis and cell phone stores remain thematic targets.
- The number of victims of domestic violence dropped slightly from the previous year but were 10% below the 5-year average baseline. Level 1 (common) sexual assaults increased. Reports of domestic conflict also increased by 8% over average.
- Property crime volumes have begun to increase since the pandemic, returning to average levels. Thefts, including from vehicles, shoplifting and general theft drove the increase. Break & enters of dwelling were 18% below average and commercial break and enters were at average levels. Thefts of vehicles returned to average levels.
- The number of young offenders identified in the 2nd Quarter dropped 27%, with the reduction in property crime involvement driving the overall decrease with a 50% reduction. The number youth offenders identified in violent crime dropped 19% from average.
- The total number of police service requests was 12% lower than the five-year average. Citizen use of the online reporting system grew by 70% in the 2nd Quarter; . In the 2nd Quarter police attended an average of 1,002 calls a day. Online citizen reports averaged 63 per day.
- There was a 5% reduction in calls about disorderly behaviours. Calls about mental health concerns, unwanted guests, threats, disturbances and property damage increased. Reductions were seen in the number of unwanted guests, intoxicated persons, indecent acts, suspicious activity, noise, and party complaints decreased most notably. Disorder calls accounted for an average of 282 calls a day from the public.

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REPORT NOTES

Most of the statistical data in this report is derived from the Calgary Police Service records management system (SENTRY). Disorder data is derived from the Computer aided Dispatch (CAD) system. Data is compiled by the Corporate Data and Analytics Team of the Bureau of Service & Community Support.

Reporting is based on the most serious offence in the incident. Please note that offences are assigned to the month in which the offence was *reported*, which is not necessarily the month the offence occurred. The reported date is the first point in time at which the police were notified of the offence and reporting lag may vary due to circumstances (these are typically property crimes where the victim did not report the offence until a later date, or was unaware of the loss until a later date, or late-reported sexual assaults). Also note that “attempted” offences are included in these totals. Violent crime, excluding robbery, is counted by the number of victims, using the most serious offence against the victim. Robbery, and all other crime, is counted by incident using the most serious offence in the incident. Of note, cases are often cleared months and sometimes years later. Consequently, clearance rates for previous years may appear to be much higher than those of the present year. Cases “cleared by charge” and those “cleared otherwise” are included in these clearance rate totals.

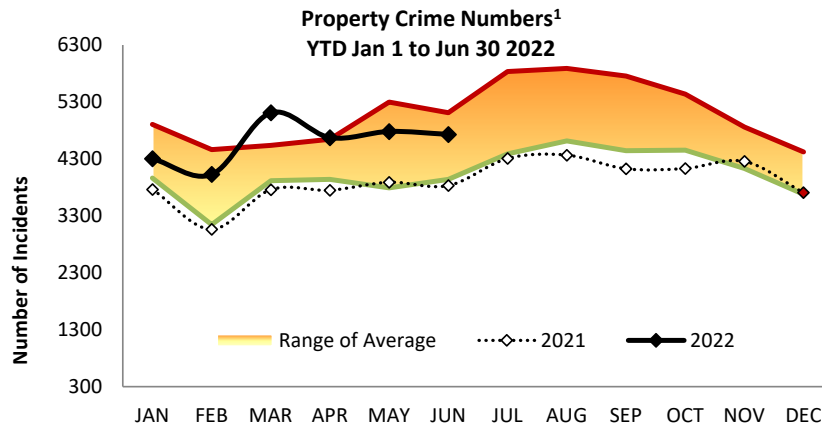

⁶****NEW****Provincial Bill 21 introduced new sanctions for impaired driving offences under the Provincial Administrative Penalties Act (PAPA) on December 1st 2021. See page 14 for additional detail on provincial Immediate Roadside Sanctions (IRS) for impaired driving. The implementation of the new provincial legislation (Provincial Administrative Penalties Act) has resulted in a significant reduction in impaired offences under the Criminal Code as most first time impaired drivers will be subject to only an IRS:FAIL (the specific administrative penalty under the Traffic Safety Act for criminal level impaired driving offences), unless the incident results in death or serious bodily harm or other significant aggravating factors in which case criminal charges should also be pursued.
