

Clearwater Park Booking Information

Clearwater Park is a secluded, fenced park site operated by the City of Calgary.

Location

24122 Township Road 241, Calgary, AB

- 7.5 km west on Highway 8, off Sarcee Trail North
- Rural ID location code 241050
- Park entrance is closed with a locked gate. The access code will be provided upon payment of the booking. Please lock the gate upon your departure.

Bookings

Bookings are accepted as of January 1 for the calendar year.

- Bookings are permitted the Friday of May long weekend until the Monday of Thanksgiving
- Bookings are available 7 days a week, 9:00am 9:00pm
- \$123.74/day + \$5.75 Risk Management Fee
- Maximum 100 people per booking.

Site Amenities

- Secluded, natural space on the banks of the Elbow River.
- Approximately 40 acres of park space available for the booking group's use.
- 3 tipis (21' in diameter) are erected yearly on wooden platforms.
- A festival tent (6m X 6m) covering 6 picnic tables.
- A cook shack with table for food preparation, fire extinguisher and first aid kit.
- 2 portable toilets (wheelchair accessible).
- 2 in-ground firepits.
- A regulation horseshoe pit (horseshoes provided).

Please note: Clearwater Park is a natural site and is inhabited by wildlife. Please use caution while on-site.



Clearwater Park Conditions of Use

Firepits

Please bring your own firewood, kindling and lighter.

When you are done with your firepit for the day, please move your firepit ashes to the galvanized steel pails provided on-site. Once cool, please dispose of the ashes with your garbage off-site.

First Aid & Emergency Procedures

A first aid kit is provided onsite in the cook shack.

In case of emergency, please contact local emergency services. Calgary emergency services will respond even though Clearwater Park is located just west of City limits. Directions to Clearwater Park are posted on the cook shack. **Dial 911 for police, fire and ambulance.**

Garbage

There are no garbage, compost or recycling services on-site. Please be prepared to take all waste back off-site with you, including ashes from your firepit.

Parking

Parking is limited, so carpooling is strongly encouraged. Up to 20 vehicles can be parked at Clearwater Park, with 10 parking spots available in the shared parking lot.

Please stay on the paved roads. Booking groups will be held responsible for damage to the turf or vegetation. Please do not drive on or park on the cement pad by the cook shack, or the area beyond it.

Toilets

Two portable toilets are on-site for your convenience (wheelchair accessible). Toilets are serviced weekly. Please **do not** dispose of any garbage or recyclables in the toilets.

Water

Please bring your own drinking water. Water from the on-site pump is non-potable.

Clearwater Park is bordered by the Elbow River and a lagoon. Please use at your own risk and use caution.

Be kind, leave nothing behind!
