

## Enmax Legacy Parks Program — Established Communities

**Project:** In 2005, a review of parks in older communities was undertaken. *The Open Space Strategy for Established Communities* (2006), was the resulting document that proposed modest enhancements to the quality of local parks as per the communities' input. Improvements focused on site furniture, plant materials, local pathways and irrigation. Enmax Legacy Parks Program allocated funds to initiate the overall program. Over 50 small projects were carried out. The balance of the requests were incorporated into the CPRIP unfunded list.

**Budget:** \$3.25M Enmax Legacy Parks Program Phase 1.

**Timeline:** Planning 2005-2006; implementation 2006-2009.  
Phase 1 completed.

An additional phase is underway, funded in the standard 2012-2014 budget cycle.

**Benefits:** This program provides modest enhancement to community level parks in the established communities that may not have a full 10% open space allocation and extends the life of these sites prior to major work being needed.
