

## School swimming lesson workbook

This workbook is used by our staff to help us complete your booking. Before you begin, please review the [Swimming lessons for schools page](#) on calgary.ca to determine the number of instructors available at your preferred location and which type of swimming lesson is right for your students.

## Requesting a school booking

Before submitting an application, you will need to:

- Divide students into groups
- Choose the times you want to book
- Know the number of instructors needed for your booking

Each lesson grouping requires its own application; for example, if you are bringing one set of students April 1-5 and a different set of students April 8-12, you would need to submit two applications.

Please find guidelines below to complete this workbook.

### Step 1: divide students into lesson groups (time slots)

Determine which students/grades will be swimming together and create lesson groups of no more than 60 students (40 for preschool and kindergarten classes)\*. Groups can include students of all ages, but classes with students in kindergarten and below cannot exceed eight swimmers.

**\*Killarney Aquatic & Recreation Centre** can accommodate up to 84 swimmers (56 preschool/kindergarten) in a single time slot.

### Step 2: determine class times

Indicate the times that each group will be swimming. We offer 30-, 45- and 60-minute classes. The classes should be back-to-back. All bookings require at least two time slots (60-minutes total). For example:

Group 1	Group 2	Group 3
Time: 9:00-9:45	Time: 9:45-10:30	Time: 10:30-11:00

### Step 3: determine the number of instructors needed

The maximum class sizes are as follows:

- Preschool and kindergarten: **8** students per swim instructor
- Grade 1 and higher: **12** students per swim instructor

If you are combining the two age categories, classes must follow the lower (1:8) ratio; you cannot have a kindergarten student in a class of 12. You can request more instructors for smaller class

sizes. Each instructor must work a minimum of one hour. The number of instructors required for the largest class will need to be used for a second class to meet this requirement.
