



78 Avenue LRT Bridge Construction Start & Scope

Notice Date: March 6, 2026

Site setup and initial work on a new LRT bridge at 78 Avenue S.E. will begin as early as March 16. The LRT bridge will be built beside the new underpass that connects 78 Avenue S.E. to Ogden Dale Road S.E.

Vehicle and pedestrian access between 78 Avenue S.E. and Ogden Dale Road S.E. will be maintained, but there will be one-lane alternating traffic with flaggers for most of the project. Expected impacts include dust, noise, and vehicle traffic associated with construction. Work is anticipated to be complete by late fall 2026.

Grading, drilling of concrete piles, and bridge and retaining wall construction



Green Line LRT

What is the work?

The 78 Avenue LRT bridge will run parallel along the west side of the Canadian Pacific Kansas City railway line. The bridge will be built beside the new underpass that connects 78 Avenue to Ogden Dale Road.

March	Site setup and initial works, incl. fencing, site clearing, topsoil stripping, and multi-use pathway & curb demolition (section under underpass)
April-May	Preparation of the embankment, incl. excavation and backfill Piling
Late May-Aug	Construction of retaining walls and bridge abutments Deck and girder installation Reconstruction of multi-use pathway
Sept-late fall	Installation of bridge barriers and finalization of structure Site cleanup

What to expect during construction:

- One-lane alternating traffic through the 78 Avenue underpass with traffic flaggers
- Overnight closure of 78 Avenue for girder installation (approx. two nights)
- Construction can be noisy, and vibrations may be felt during work hours
- While mitigations will be in place, there may be dust, soil, and debris in the area
- Weather permitting, work will generally occur Monday to Friday from 7:00 am to 5:00 p.m. Some Saturday and night shifts may be required.

About Green Line LRT – SE Project

The S.E. Segment, from Shepard in the southeast to the Event Centre/Grand Central Station in the Beltline, will build the first 16 kilometres of an overall 46-kilometre vision, before connecting with the future Downtown Segment and into the existing Red and Blue LRT Lines. Including the Downtown Segment, Phase 1 will build, 17.2 kilometres of twin-track LRT infrastructure, 12 new stations, a maintenance and storage facility, three Park and Ride lots, and 28 new modern low-floor light rail vehicles.
