Tourism

A new facility meets the growing demand for hosting opportunities and reigniting Calgary's legacy as a premier Canadian sport destination:

Economy

- 1,500 jobs created through construction and operation.
- Increase in annual net **new economic activity** - \$20M - \$63M.
- Strengthens Calgary's visitor economy by converting sport participation into consistent tourism demand.

Wellbeing

- Based on calculations, physical inactivity costs the health care system **\$3.9 billion per year.** (www.measuring-impact.ca)
- **51% of Canadian adults and 72% of children and youth** do not meet physical activity guidelines.
- A 10-percentage point decrease in physical inactivity across the population, could reduce health care spending by about **\$629 million per year.**



A year-round, multi-use destination designed for:

- Community recreation
- Sport development for all
- National and international events

Key amenities include:

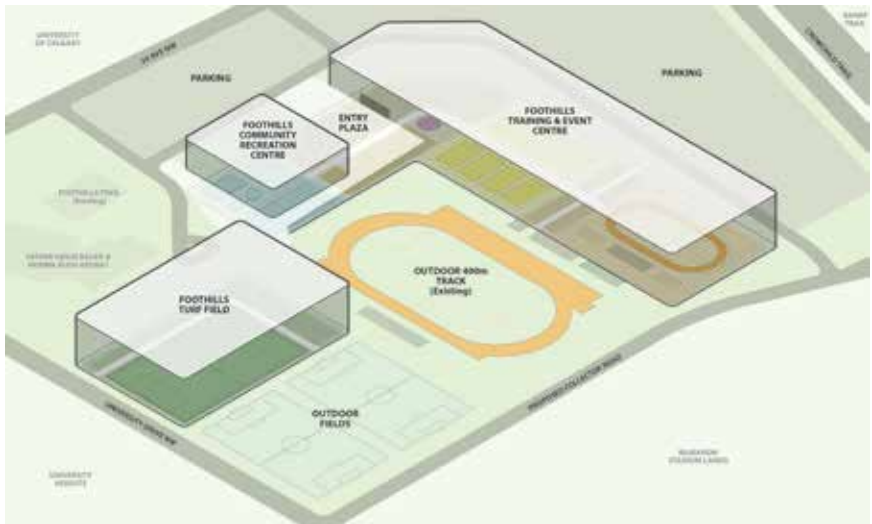
- **FIFA-sized** indoor artificial turf field.
- A **World Athletics-standard** indoor track and field facility, including a 200-metre hydraulic banked track and 3,000 seating capacity.
- Multi-court gymnasias with six regular courts, and two multi-activity courts.
- A state-of-the-art fitness facility.
- Supporting amenities, including large public gathering spaces, multi-purpose rooms, and event-hosting capabilities.
- Serves as a flexible, large-scale asset in times of emergency.



Shared Investment. Shared Action. Shared Impact.

- The City has earmarked \$109M to make the multisport fieldhouse a reality.
- Enabling works could begin as early as 2027.
- Partnerships will bring this project to life to support recreation needs locally, provincially and nationally.
