



Bearspaw South Feeder Main

Background

The City is moving forward with the Bearspaw South Feeder Main (BSFM) Improvements Project, a critical step in strengthening Calgary's water system. We are implementing a revised plan that urgently expedites construction of a replacement for the Bearspaw South Feeder Main due to the critical condition of the current pipe. The project will add a parallel steel pipe of the same size as the existing BSFM. Over time, this new pipe will take over service from the current line.

As part of this project, The City will be continuing early investigation and preparatory work in your neighbourhood.

- **February 18 - 25, 2026:** geotechnical investigation activities.
- **February 20 - March 10, 2026:** non-invasive pipe lining and cleaning at manholes.

Work location

This work is planned to take place along 34 Avenue N.W. between 73 Street N.W. and 89 Street N.W.

Scope of work

Geotechnical activities:

- Work includes borehole drilling to collect soil and groundwater information.
- Test holes will be drilled along 34 Avenue NW.

Non-invasive pipe lining and cleaning:

- Crews will be accessing pipes via manholes throughout 34 Avenue N.W.
- No new excavation will be required.
- Crews will move block-by-block, spending approx. 4-hours in each work area.

Construction impacts

- Temporary, localized traffic controls will be in place near work zones.
- Construction-related noise and dust.
- Equipment in the area. All equipment is temporary and will be removed once testing is complete.
