Respondents who identify as having a disability are more likely to be unsatisfied with street accessibility (55%).

Respondents describe feeling unsafe on this street due to the presence of people experiencing houselessness and drug addiction, particularly around the intersection of 37 Street SW and 17 Avenue SW.
