Deep utility construction

We are reaching out to share information regarding upcoming deep utility construction in your area related to the Belmont Fieldhouse and Library. Deep utilities include potable water lines, sanitary lines and storm water infrastructure.

This construction will result in the removal of some trees, however, the project is scheduled to plant numerous new trees during the final phase of construction in 2027. We are working with The City of Calgary Urban Forestry team to ensure a healthy tree canopy is present at the Belmont Fieldhouse and Library.

Schedule

Deep utility construction is scheduled to begin in your area the week of Oct. 27, 2025, and is anticipated to be complete by the end of November 2025, weather dependent. Any outstanding deep utility construction that is not completed due to inclement weather may be shifted to the spring months in 2026.

Construction impacts

We anticipate closures to open spaces, sidewalks and streets during the deep utility construction.

Open field closure:

To ensure public and worker safety, parts of the open field located south of Belmont Ave. S.W., will be closed to the public during the deep utility construction. Please watch for signage.

First road closure:

The first road closure is anticipated to begin on **Monday, Oct. 27**, along a portion of **Belmont Ave., east of Belmont St. S.W.**, and is expected to last approximately one week.

Traffic along Belmont Ave. will be impacted, however, vehicle access to Belview Apartments from Belmont St. will remain open. Please watch for road closure and detour signage.

We recognize this road closure will impact community members who park their vehicles on Belmont Ave., and hope to have the work complete within the anticipated schedule.

Second road closure:

The second road closure is anticipated to begin on **Monday**, **Nov. 10**, at the intersection of **Belmont Ave. and Belmont St. S.W.**, and is expected to last approximately one week.

Traffic along Belmont Ave. will be impacted, however, vehicle access to Belview Apartments from Belmont St. will remain open. Please watch for road closure and detour signage.

Third road closure:

The third road closure is anticipated to begin on **Monday, Nov. 17**, along **Belmont Ave., east of Belmont Dr. S.W.**, and is expected to last approximately ten days.

Traffic travelling eastbound and westbound along Belmont Ave., between Belmont Dr. and Belmont St. S.W., will be impacted. Please watch for road closure and detour signage.

Project background

We are building the Belmont Fieldhouse and Library located near the intersection of 210 Ave. and Creekside Blvd. S.W. The facility will include a public library, multi-sport rectangular field and supporting amenities. Library and recreation infrastructure is vital for vibrant communities, promoting health and well-being. This facility is expected to be a focal point of activity in the community, providing a wide range of programs and services to meet social, recreational and cultural needs.

In addition to the fieldhouse and library, new traffic lights will be installed at the intersection of 210 Ave. and Creekside Blvd. S.W., to best manage future traffic in the area and to provide safe pedestrian access to the facility.
