School Connections - First Time Login Process

Signing into the system for the first time may take 15-30 minutes depending on your internet connection and your experience with DUO Mobile – an authenticator tool used for Multi- Factor Authentication at CBE.

- If you are signing in for the 1st time, proceed with the following steps.
- If you have already completed enrollment steps and have been successful with signing-in, go to the <u>Subsequent Login</u> section. Subsequent logins are much quicker.
- 1. The City of Calgary has sent you an email invitation to enroll in the SC YYC database. The invitation is sent from invites@microsoft.com:


2. Click on the 'Accept Invitation' link in the invitation email and you will be redirected to the landing page for the School Connections YYC login portal: https://schoolconnections.calgary.ca

*Note: All new users must not only accept the invitation, but also login to create a profile in the SC YYC database. Failure to login will result in having to complete in the enrollment process again.

3. Click on Sign In.



4. Click on **Azure AD** button. CBE staff will use their existing Active Directory accounts. Only Community organizations use their myID business accounts for sign-in.



Please note: CBE uses the <u>Duo Mobile</u> application for 2FA. You will need to download this on your mobile device (iOS or Android). The CBE's preferred method is to use the "Send me a Push" option.








5. Enter your CBE email and current password. Click Sign In.




You may also see a Sign in pop-up appear. Enter your CBE email and password. Click Sign in.




6. Click on Send me a Push.




7. Review permissions and click Accept.




8. Set up Multi-Factor Authentication. Click Next.



9. Do not click on Next. Click on I want to use a different authenticator app link.




10. Click on Next.




11. Use **Duo Mobile** on your mobile device to scan the QR code and click **Next**. Go to step 12.




11.1. Open Duo Mobile on your mobile device, click the '+' sign.




11.2. Using the camera on your mobile device, scan the barcode shown on the computer screen. It should automatically move to the next step when scanned.



11.3. Click on MAYBE LATER to skip the password recovery setting.




11.4. Review the account setting then click on the "go-back" arrow to return to the DUO main screen.



11.5. You will see that a 6-digit code has been generated.


If the 6-digit code does not show up, make sure to click on the toggle down arrow.

*Note: The code will expire in 30 seconds. If the code is not entered within the timeframe, it will refresh, giving you a new code to enter within 30 seconds.




12. Enter the 6-digit code shown in **Duo Mobile** on your mobile device and click **Next**.


*Note: If your network connection is slow when entering the code, it could time out. You can go back to step 11.5 to generate a new code.




13. Click Done.




14. Your Profile page appears showing your First Name, Last Name and E-mail.


17.1 Select all text in the Name field and delete it.



17.2 Type in **School Connections YYC** then select the Checkmark to apply.




17.3 You will now see the updated Name displayed in Duo Mobile.





18. With your mobile device open **Duo Mobile**, click the **EDIT** button located at the top left of your screen.




18.1. Click anywhere in the new authentication area (Microsoft – Email portion)


*Do not select the red minus icon, it will remove the entry.




18.2. Select all text in the Account name field and delete it.




18.3 Type in School Connections YYC and click Save.



18.4 Select **Done**.




18.5 You will now see the updated Name displayed in Duo Mobile.








5. Enter your CBE email for Username and your current CBE password then click Sign In.








- 7. You should receive a Microsoft **Verification Code** on your mobile device. In the Duo Mobile app, click on the toggle down arrow to display the authentication Code.
- *Note: The code will expire in 30 seconds. if not entered within the timeframe the code will refresh, giving you a new code to enter within 30 seconds.




