



Auburn Bay Corridor Safety Improvements - Feedback

What have we heard?

Improvement type	Feedback	Response
Temporary curb extensions and speed cushions	Citizens are happy with the locations of proposed improvements as it will help with pedestrian safety, speed, and volume of motorists.	Temporary curb extensions will be installed, and locations will be evaluated for future permanent infrastructure.
Speed cushions	Request for additional speed cushions along Auburn Shores Way S.E.	Additional speed cushions were not planned as part of this pilot but can be considered in the future.
Speed cushions	Citizen is concerned about the location of the speed cushions as lower clearance vehicles may not be able to maneuver around them.	As this is a very special requirement, an alternate access in and out of the community is available.
Temporary curb extensions	Intersection at Auburn Shores Way S.E. and Auburn Bay Boulevard S.E. will have congestion issues due to the right turn lane reduction.	The volumes along these two corridors are fairly low, and it is expected that congestion issues will be minimal.
Temporary curb extensions	Concerns with temporary curb extensions, they are unaesthetic and reduce available parking which will lead to a drop in property value.	These temporary measures will be evaluated and potentially made permanent in the future.
Crosswalk improvements	Request for marked and signed crosswalks at various locations.	All requests for playground zones, improved signage, road markings and crosswalks will be reviewed and implemented if warranted.
