



If it's time to turn on your sprinklers – it's time to get your system tested

The *Water Utility Bylaw* requires homeowners and businesses with:

- in-ground irrigation
- heating or cooling systems
- fire suppression sprinklers

to undergo an annual test to ensure the cross connection device functions properly. It's one way we can help protect the quality and safety of our drinking water.



Keep Calgary's drinking water safe

Cross connection devices in homes and businesses require annual testing to protect our drinking water system.

For residents with underground sprinklers, tests must be completed **before** the sprinklers are turned on for the season.

What is a cross connection device?

Cross connection devices are placed on water systems such as irrigation, fire suppression, and/or industrial water systems to prevent any risk of backflow (reverse suction) of already delivered water from re-entering Calgary's drinking water system.

Book your test today

Cross connection devices must be tested every year by a certified tester.
