Pool Draining Procedure:

Anyone using a pump, or a siphon with an inside diameter greater than 1.5 inches, to drain a pool greater than 3000 Litres to the Wastewater System, must notify The City of Calgary's Industrial Monitoring Group (IMG). If the discharge rate can be maintained under 150 L/min, IMG will process your request within five business days. If the proposed discharge rate exceeds 150 L/min, IMG requires a minimum of ten business days, in order to assess the reported water quality and liaise with both the Development Planning Department, and the receiving Wastewater Treatment Plant to avoid upsets, and possible overloading of the collection system which can lead to sewer back-ups. If sufficient notice is not provided, the proposed discharge may have to be delayed. All discharges must comply with the Wastewater Bylaw. Please provide the following information.
