The City has moved to stage three water restrictions and the State of Local Emergency has expired. Work on the [Gladstone Connect project](#) will resume.

Construction Impacts:

- An increase in on-site construction activity including construction crews, vehicles, and heavy equipment. For safety, fencing will be installed around construction areas and on-site signage installed.
- Noise, vibrations, and dust. Noise levels will be monitored.
- Temporary water service, and possible water shut-offs for nearby buildings.
- No access to on-street parking.
- Regular hours will be 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Saturday.

Sunnyside Flood Barrier

Construction on the Sunnyside Flood Barrier is officially kicking off, with the first phase of work beginning in late July.

Anticipated construction schedule*:

Beginning July 22, 2024
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sheet pile installation from 10 St N.W. to 14 St N.W. • Right lane of Memorial Dr N.W. eastbound will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. • Duration: Approximately two weeks.
Beginning July 29, 2024
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Concrete pile drilling for barrier footings around the Princes Island Park Pedestrian Bridge. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ The pathway width will be reduced. • Drainage pipe installation between Centre St and 9 St N.W. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Both eastbound lanes of Memorial Dr N.W. will be closed and two-way traffic on westbound Memorial Dr will be established. • Duration: Approximately three months.
Early August 2024
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sheet pile installation on the regional pathway along Memorial Dr N.W. from 10 St N.W. to 14 St N.W. • The regional pathway will be closed. • Duration: Approximately five weeks.

Pathway Information:

During construction sections of the Bow River pathway between 14 St N.W. and Centre St will be impacted. Pathway users will be provided detours to ensure safety and connectivity.

Commuter cyclists will be encouraged to use the downtown pathway (south side of Bow River) during construction.
