Construction Update: Bearspaw South Feeder Main Repair

The City of Calgary is in the final stages of making urgent repairs to sections of the Bearspaw South Feeder Main. The majority of these repairs are taking place along a section of 33 Ave N.W. and along 16 Ave N.W. as well as a section at Shouldice Park.

UPDATE: 33 Ave. N.W.

Our crews are in final stages of construction, backfilling and repaving the road on 33 Avenue N.W. As of today, crews will be moving to daytime only shifts starting today, which will now eliminate overnight noise from this work for residents along 33rd Avenue.

At worksites 2 and 3 which are located between 78 St N.W. and 83 St N.W., curb and gutter work is underway and we expect to open this section of 33 Ave N.W. east of 83 St N.W. by Tuesday.

We are continuing to work at sites 1 and 5 which are located west of 83 St N.W. These sections of 33 Ave N.W. will reopen next week.

Parking restrictions along 34 Ave N.W. east of 83 St N.W. have now been removed and parking is once again permitted along this stretch of the road.

UPDATE: 16 Ave. N.W.

Paving is now complete along 16 Ave N.W. and we are pleased to let you know that the road reopened this morning. There will still be localized lane closures near 43 St N.W. to accommodate staff and equipment for sampling and monitoring as they bring the feeder main back into service.

Sidewalk, Curb, and Driveway Restoration

Once our crews finish repaying the road, we will begin restoring sidewalks, curbs, and driveways.

Landscaping Restoration

As landscaping design varies across the neighbourhood, we will be assessing each affected area to determine the appropriate time for restoration. In some cases, certain plants/landscaping may not survive the winter if replanted now. We will discuss specific circumstances with individual homeowners.
